ARRIVAL - GENERAL TRANSPORT

NOTE:

Please do not hesitate to contact the local organization committee (cmft2001@mail.ua.pt) if you feel that you would need some special support concerning your arrival.

FROM OPORTO AIRPORT TO AVEIRO:

At Oporto Airport you can take a taxi to the main railway station **Campanhã** (or the busses Nr. 56 and 87 to the terminal, then Nr. 32 to Campanhã). The taxi fare is about 15 Euro and the train fare to Aveiro is 3-10 Euro. There are different types of trains, cheap local trains ("Suburbanos"), which departing every hour and need one hour to arrive in Aveiro, and more expensive fast trains ("Alfas" or "IC", timetable can be found below). If you are part of a group you can consider the possibility of taking a taxi directly to Aveiro. It costs about 60 Euro (12000PTE) and you are advised to confirm the price with the driver beforehand. You can ask for a receipt.

Another possibility is the airport shuttle (AeroBus), which connects the airport with various hotels in Oporto (580 PTE, passengers of TAP can use it free of charge). To continue to Aveiro directly we suggest to leave the bus at "Aliados" and take a local train ("Suburbano", free of charge) from "São Bento" to "Campanhã" or directly to Aveiro (Direction "Coimbra", ticket about 3 Euro).

SPECIAL CMFT-BUS-SERVICE FROM OPORTO AIRPORT TO AVEIRO:

As announced, on **SUNDAY, June 24**, there will be a **free bus service from Oporto airport to Aveiro**, departing three times from the airport. A representative of the local organizers will be present at the airport (arrival hall) from 12:00 hrs. onwards (he will carry a CMFT sign) and will direct you to the place of departure.

If you choose to DRIVE from Oporto to Aveiro, take the A1 motorway southbound and take exit "Aveiro - IP5". You should then follow the IP5 road for about 12 km and take the exit "Aveiro Oeste" which leaves you near the university and the center of Aveiro.

FROM LISBON AIRPORT TO AVEIRO:

If you arrive at Lisbon Airport you can take a taxi to the train station Gare do Oriente and from there a train to Aveiro (timetables available on <http://www.cp.pt>). The fastest (and recommended) trains are the Intercidades and Alfa services with fares of about 15-20 Euro. The journey to Aveiro takes about 2h30min. Due to the excellent train connections to Aveiro you can avoid long waiting times at Lisbon. We regret that we are not able to organize a bus service from Lisbon airport to Aveiro.

Participants with an overnight stay in Lisbon can use the airport shuttle (AeroBus), which connects the airport with various hotels in Lisbon (passengers of TAP can use it free of charge).

If you DRIVE from Lisbon to Aveiro, take the A1 motorway northbound and take exit "Aveiro Sul". When entering the town of Aveiro you will find the university on your left.

OTHER IMPORTANT INFORMATION

TOURIST PROGRAM:

On **Monday morning** after registration there will be a **guided visit** of the university campus and some central and useful places in Aveiro (banks, shopping centre, bus station to the beach, tourist information, etc.) for the accompanying persons.

Together with a travel agency the local organization prepared proposals for **2 daily BUS TRIPS** (Tuesday and Thursday) and **one smaller bus trip** (Friday) to places in the vicinity of Aveiro (including visits to **Buçaco**, one of the most beautiful forests in Portugal with rare botanic species and its Royal Palace of Neo Manuelin architecture, to the wine cellar "**Caves Aliança**", and to the "**Vista Alegre**" porcelain factory and museum).

HEALTH SERVICES:

Consultations are given at the Centro de Saúde (Public Health Centre) through the "Serviço de Atendimento Permanente" (SAP), where you should go in **the first instance**.

Who can use SAP?

European Union Citizens holding the E111 or E128 health certificate; Brazilian citizens holding the PB4 health certificate; International researchers enrolled in the Portuguese Social Security System; Portuguese nationals enrolled in the Portuguese Social Security System. Note: If you do not have access to the SAP user card, you may still use the service but have to pay full rates.

IMPORTANT HINT:

The organizers suggest that participants who are not covered by SAP should get a health insurance for the duration of their stay in Portugal. Urgent Medical Assistance is available in hospitals providing 24 hours a day emergency service. In case of **emergency dial 112**.

PHARMACIES:

A green cross, which will be lit up at night, identifies pharmacies, if the pharmacy is on duty. When it is closed there will be a notice in the window showing the nearest pharmacy on duty, which is open 24 hours a day. The Portuguese word for pharmacy is **farmácia**. The addresses and telephone numbers of the particular pharmacy on weekend and night duty are provided in the local newspapers and in the front windows of all pharmacies.

ELECTRICITY:

Voltage: 220/380 volts at a frequency of 50 Hertz. All sockets follow European standards. To use American-type plugs, a 220-volt transformer should be used together with an adapter plug.

CURRENCY:

The **currency of Portugal is the Portuguese Escudo (PTE)**, the symbol for which looks like this: \$.

The different denominations of the Escudo notes and coins include 5 notes and 6 coins.

The notes are: 10,000; 5,000; 2,000; 1,000 and 500.

The coins are: 200; 100; 50; 20; 10 and 5.

The **conversion rate of the Euro in relation to the Escudo is:** 1 Euro= 200.482 PTE

CREDIT CARDS:

Credit cards (such as American Express, Eurocard/MasterCard and Visa) are widely accepted in Portugal (but **not** as the form of payment of the conference fee).

AUTOMATIC CASH MACHINES AND CASH CARDS:

Portugal has a national network of ATMs (Automatic teller Machines), known as Multibanco, which allows the withdrawal of up to 40,000 PTE per day on cash cards. Machines are located in banks, shops, petrolstations and other convenient places. Multibanco point-of-sale devices are also in wide use in shops, restaurants, cafés, etc.

Multibanco machines recognize the international cash **cards Visa International, Eurocheque, Cirrus, and American Express**. In addition, cards, which function through the following networks, are accepted (ask your bank at home for advice about which network your card works through):
